## Short term goal:

- I would provide methods that teachers could use to tie-in the content in more hands on fashion for their students.
- **We would like to give each teacher that attends a copy of curriculum on environmental economics.**
- If we have our maximum number of teachers attend that would be 20 copies of the curriculum, which would cost **\$220.00**

# What do we hope to do with your help:

## Long term goal:

- We would love to bring this curriculum to each elementary, middle school and high school in Waynesboro, Staunton and Augusta County.
- We would offer training to teachers at each school division to help implement this curriculum and encourage cross-curricular education.
- We would need roughly 20 elementary school curriculum and 20 middle school and high school curriculum to achieve this goal.
- This would cost an additional **\$485**.
- Total cost for both the long term and short term goals with curriculum: **\$705**
